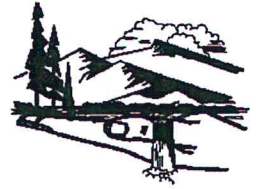

The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality – Land Quality Division (WDEQ/LQD) District 2 Office received Lost Creek ISR's (LCI) Non-Significant Revision (NSR) to Permit 788 to incorporate the topsoil policy language from the WDEQ-LQD letter dated March 2, 2017 into the Operations Plan. The NSR also incorporated supplemental subsoil analysis data into the permit as Attachment D7-3 Supplement appended to Appendix D7 Attachment D7-3. All proposed changes are acceptable.
