
The purpose of this letter is to discuss Florida Power & Light actions to address the recommendations of the Regulatory Effectiveness Review (RER) at Turkey Points Units 3 and 4. These recommendations were the subject of a meeting at the NRC Bethesda offices on September 12, 1986.

The RER recommendations concerning the defensive positions, fence protection system, and bridge over the discharge canal are being addressed by projects which have been included in the most recent version of the Integrated Schedule. This Integrated Schedule is the subject of a proposed license amendment which is currently undergoing NRC review. Upon approval of this amendment, the completion dates for the physical security modifications will be as provided by the Integrated Schedule process.

The vital barriers recommendation is to be addressed by a project which will also be part of the Integrated Schedule. We are reviewing previous studies we have prepared on this issue. This previous work will be used as the basis to prepare the necessary information required to include the vital barriers project into the Integrated Schedule. The schedule process will then determine the completion date.
