SUBJECT: PLANT SHUTDOWN EXCEEDING 48 HOURS

On April 27, 1988, at 8:08 p.m. (EDT), the licensee commenced a shutdown of the unit due to increasing reactor coolant system (RCS) leakage. The leak rate increased to 3.1 gallons per minute (gpm) and was due to a leaking pressurizer spray valve. The Technical Specification limit for identified leakage is 10 gpm.

The licensee reports that the reactor was shutdown by 12:29 a.m. (EDT) on April 28 (today). The unit will be off-line for approximately ten (10) days.

The resident inspectors will conduct routine followup.

The State of Florida will be informed.

The NRC received initial notification of this event via telephone from the resident inspector to Region II at 8:00 a.m. (EDT) on April 28.
