On April 25, 1988 the NRC issued Amendments 128 and 122 to Facility Operating Licenses DPR-31 and DPR-41 for Turkey Point Units 3 and 4, respectively. These amendments deleted the remaining Sections 1.0 and 5.0 of the Turkey Point Environmental Technical Specifications (ETS) and replaced them with an Environmental Protection Plan (EPP). The implementation date for the EPP was June 25, 1988.

Section 5.4.1 of the ETS for Turkey Point Units 3 and 4 required the submittal of a Non-Radiological Environmental Monitoring Report annually. The report is due to the NRC by March 31 of the year following the reporting year.

This Annual Report is being submitted to fulfill the reporting requirements of Section 5.4.1 of the ETS for the period January 1, 1988 through June 25, 1988. Since the EPP does not require the submittal of an Annual Report this will be the last Annual Report submitted to satisfy ETS requirements.

Growth rates of all recaptured animals were positive.


