Enclosed is an application from RSB Logistic Inc., dated November 27, 2017, requesting Amendment No. 07 to its existing export license XSOU8798/06. This license presently authorizes the export of up to 12,000,000 kilograms of natural uranium to Canada, in the form of ore concentrate (U_3O_8) for conversion into UF_6 , UO_2 , or UO_3 , and return to the U.S. for future processing.

The purpose of the amendment is to amend the name of an "Other Party(ies) to Export," and extend the license date of expiration from December 31, 2017, to December 31, 2022.

Since there are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested, our office is processing this as a minor amendment. We intend to issue the requested license after the 30-day time period allotted for public review has expired, and it is determined that applicable export license criteria are met.
