Additionally, each Board member assigned an area of responsibility is to prepare a view graph of strengths and weaknesses to be displayed and discussed during the SALP Board meeting.

Each designated member has the responsibility to inform me and/or the Board Chairperson within one week from the date of this memo, if there is some compelling reason such as unavailability or circumstances that might be perceived as influencing objectivity, that would prevent service on the Board or could create the perception of unfavorable bias in the deliberations.
