AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Gentlemen:

This refers to an inspection to assure public health and safety conducted on September 3 through October 14, 1995, at the Turkey Point facility. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities authorized by the license were conducted safely and in accordance with NRC requirements. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has determined that a violation of NRC requirements occurred. The violation is cited in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice) and the circumstances surrounding it are described in detail in the subject inspection report. The violation is of concern because prior opportunities for corrective actions failed to adequately resolve a long standing design issue associated with high component cooling water flow that could have potentially caused failures in the heat exchangers due to vibration. Although your staff identified this issue and normally Severity Level IV citations meeting the criteria of Section VII.B.1 of the Enforcement Policy are Non-Cited Violations, this issue is being cited because of the multiple prior opportunities to identify and adequately correct the condition, including during the Service Water System Operational Performance Inspection (SWOPI) that was conducted by you during March - May, 1995.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. Your response should also specifically address existing or planned changes to the review process that adequately address corrective actions following identification of potential design concerns. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.
