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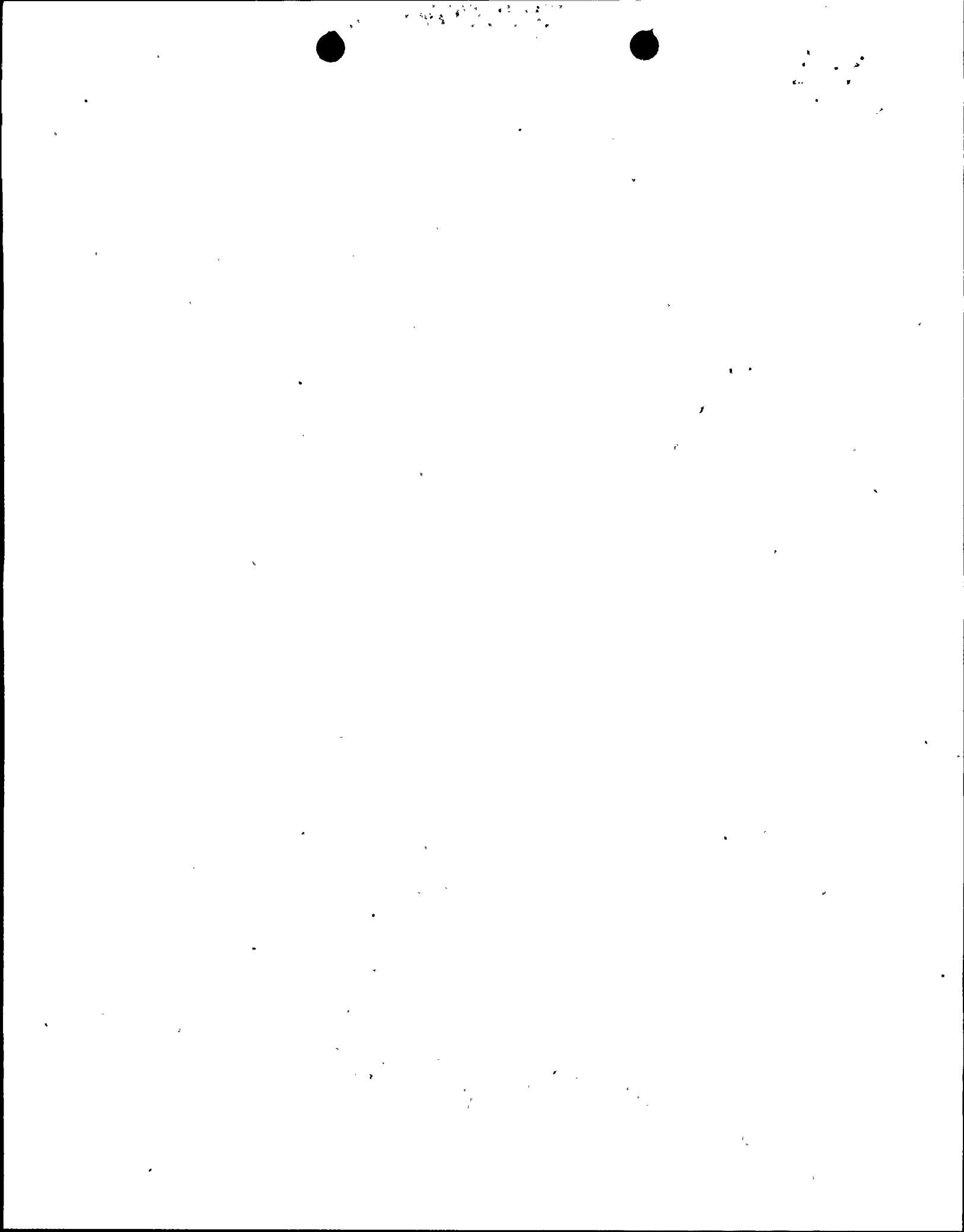

**Fitness for Duty Reportable Event**

On May 2, 1996, a confirmed positive random test result was received on a Licensed Operator, for Marijuana at 40 ng/ml. Telephone notification to the NRC was made at 1333 hours on May 2, 1996. A review was conducted, with negative results, of the subject's work activities for a period prior to the test. Details of the event were reported to the NRC in our letter L-96-134 of May 29, 1996.

\* One of the positive Marijuana pre-access test results was below the DHHS/NRC cutoff level. The level was 14ng/ml THC on the GCMS . Our cutoff level on GCMS for Marijuana is 10 ng/ml , where the DHHS/NRC cutoff level is 15ng/ml.





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
