Subject: HURRICANE LILI

Hurricane LiLi is located at latitude 22.7 N and longitude 81.6 W as of 8:00 a.m., October 18, 1996. The Turkey Point Plant is located at latitude 25.4 N and longitude 80.4 W. The licensee has completed preparations for the hurricane. However, the licensee is not projecting hurricane winds at the Turkey Point site. Both units at Turkey Point are currently at 100 percent power.

Additional Region II personnel are at St. Lucie and Crystal River to augment the Turkey Point Resident staff as needed. The Emergency Response Vehicle arrived in Florida, and is prepared to respond as needed. The Region II State Agreement Officer is at the State Emergency Operations Center in Tallahassee, Florida.

Region II personnel are closely tracking the progress of the Hurricane and Resident Inspectors are onsite at Turkey Point monitoring licensee activities.

The State of Florida has been informed.
