Subject: HURRICANE LILI - UPDATE

Hurricane LiLi is presently located at latitude 22.4 N and longitude 80.3 W as of 2:00 p.m., October 18, 1996. The Turkey point Plant is located at latitude 25.4 N and longitude 80.4 W. Hurricane LiLi is moving Eastward at 10 MPH. The tropical storm warning is discontinued for the Florida Keys and Bay. However, Region II continues to monitor Hurricane Lili and Resident Inspectors are onsite to monitor licensee activities. Both units at Turkey Point are currently at 100 percent power.
