OI determined that there was insufficient evidence to substantiate the allegation of discrimination. We plan no further action with regard to this matter. We will continue to monitor the outcome of the DOL activity for any potential enforcement actions that may be warranted. SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Office of Investigations, Region II, on July 9, 1996, to determine whether the Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) illegally discriminated against a former instrumentation and calibration specialist at the FPL Turkey Point Nuclear Plant.

The evidence developed in this investigation does not substantiate the allegation that FPL illegally discriminated against the employee in question.
