Dear Ms. Monday:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), is returning without further action, the application for import license IW031 (enclosed).

The reason for the return is that the radioactive material proposed to be imported, as described in the application, does not meet the definition of radioactive waste as per Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 110.2. This was discussed with you on December 12, 2017. As such, the material can be imported under a general license, in accordance with 10 CFR 110.27.
