Enclosed is an application, dated November 29, 2017, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from TN Americas LLC, for amendment No. 03 to its existing license, XSNM3722/02. The license presently authorizes the export of low-enriched uranium to France for fuel fabrication and then to the Netherlands for ultimate use as fuel elements for High Flux Research Reactor in Petten, or for use in medical isotope production in the Mallinckrodt Molybdenum Production Facility.

The purpose of the amendment is to amend the name of the "Intermediate Consignee(s)," and extend the license date of expiration from December 31, 2017, to December 31, 2019.

There are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested. Therefore, our office is processing this as a minor amendment, and intends to issue the license after the required 30-day review period.
