Dear Mr. Denton,

I am writing in regard to the Shearon Harris Nuclear Plant in North Carolina. I do not believe the plant is 100% safe. I understand that the NRC has done inspections and heard testimony that it is safe, but I know that a few overlooked errors in workmanship in a nuclear power facility can lead to disaster. I know, and there is documentation, that there was a lot of drug usage by workers at Shearon Harris. I would only feel safe, knowing that, if you could assure me that the NRC had inspected every weld and every valve and every pump, which of course is not feasible.

The evacuation plan in case of an

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accident is not workable. One county has recinded participation in the evacuation plan. The state of N.C. has not yet come up with how it will cover that county — and when/if it does — that evacuation plan will need testing. If you lived within 25 miles of Shearon Harris I would guess you would want more assurances of safety than we have right now.

Please do not grant C, P & L an exemption from a full-scale exercise of the evacuation plan. To do so would endanger many lives.

You have a tough job. I hope you pray.
