Dear Mr. Denton,

As you know, the Carolina Power and Light Company (CP+L) of North Carolina intends to open its Shearon Harris nuclear Power Plant later this year despite widespread and on-going opposition to the plant. As the opening date approaches, more and more of us in the Raleigh-Durham area are frightened because of the lack of a comprehensive evacuation plan.

CP+L cannot guarantee 100% there will never be a nuclear accident at their plant; their safety record now, before the plant is opened, is very shabby. If the 25 mile area surrounding the plant had to be evacuated (as in Chernobyl), more than 250,000 people would be scrambling to leave on an inadequate road system. Consequently, many would die during the evacuation alone.

Please, please require CP+L to form a comprehensive evacuation plan for the 25^{mile} radius around the plant. Require them to make the plan known to the public. and please, inspect the Shearon Harris Plant thoroughly and completely.
Our lives here depend on it.
