Status of Recommendations

Recommendation 2: Formalize and implement a process for maintaining current and accurate data within a centralized database.

Agency Response Dated
December 13, 2017:

In response to resolved Recommendation 2 from the OIG's audit of the NRC's Management of the Baseline Security Program (OIG-12-A-10), NSIR has developed a process outlined in office procedure ADM 120, "Collection of Security Inspection Program Findings to Support Oversight and Assessment Functions", to facilitate the collection of security inspection program findings data from a centralized database ensuring the most current and accurate data is used. The procedure directs the use of the Replacement Reactor Program System as the primary source of information from which security inspection findings are collected and consolidated for use in various inspection program oversight and assessment functions that NSIR staff are responsible to implement.

OIG Analysis: OIG staff has reviewed and verified implementation of NSIR's new office procedure for maintaining current and accurate security findings data in a centralized database. This recommendation is therefore considered closed.

Status: Closed.
