Dear Mr. Adams:

On April 26 and May 3, 2012, the Department conducted an inspection of your facilities and operations as they relate to radiation safety and compliance in accordance with Title 17, the California Code of Regulations and the California Health and Safety Code.

We are pleased to report at the time of our inspection no items of noncompliance were noted.

The Department has the following recommendations, comments and observations, which we believe will contribute to your ongoing radiation safety program.

- 1) You will need to contact licensing to amend your license to update the current office location in California where license documentation will be located and available for inspection.
- 2) While survey meters are not kept on site and are only used by authorized users when they do their site visits, a copy of the survey meter calibrations should be forwarded to the records location along with the survey meter results/site visit report.
- 3) You should ensure that Title 17 is up to date and your copy of 10 CFR 20 is the January 1, 2008 version.


