

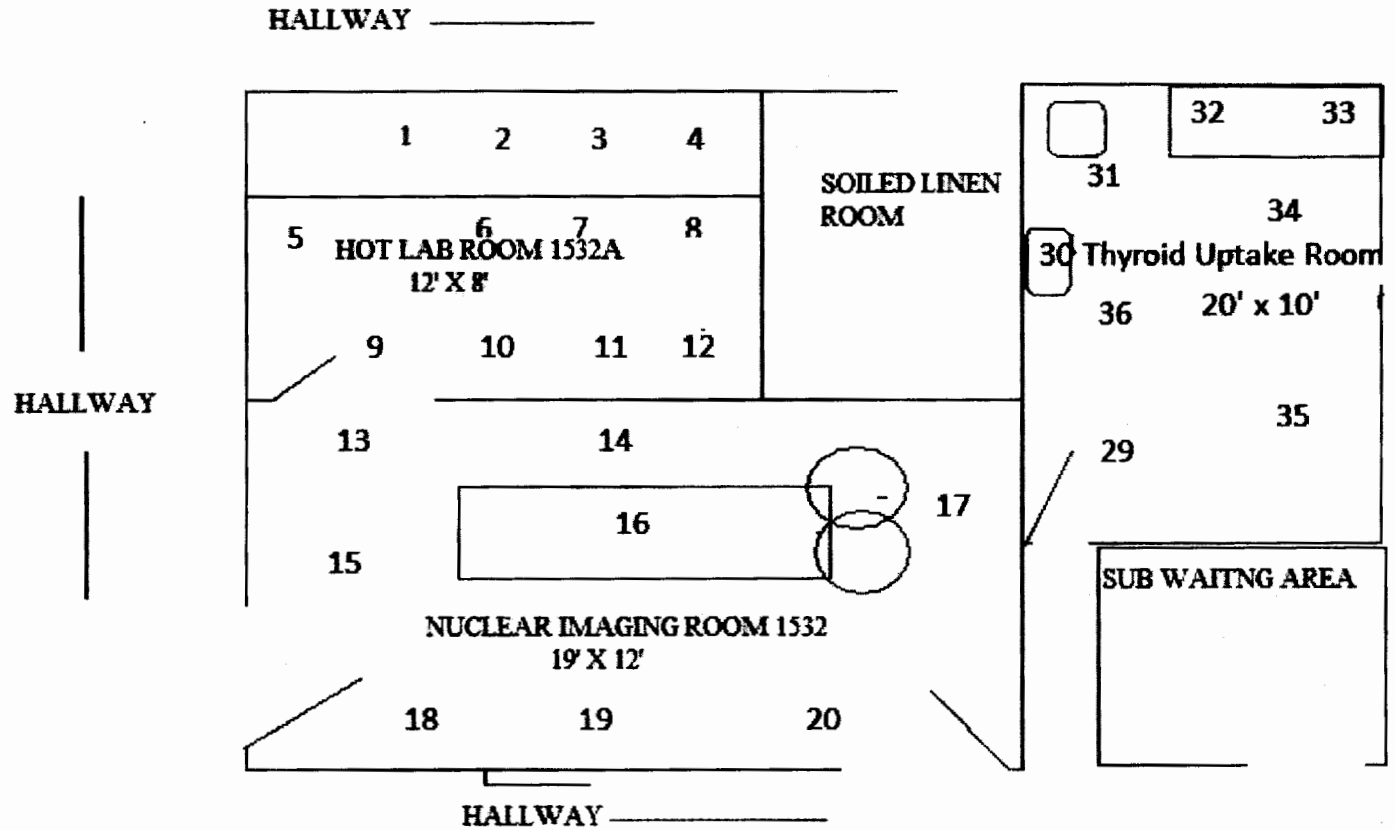

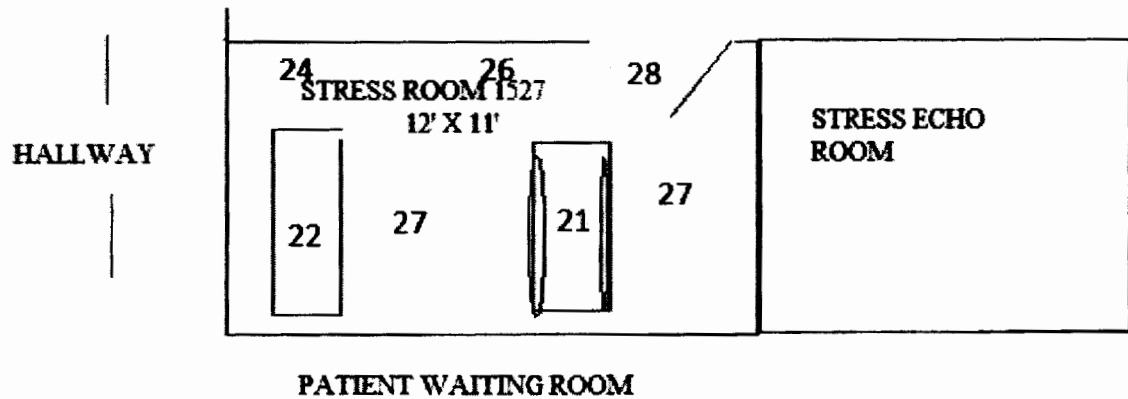
FACILITY DIAGRAM


