SUBJECT: UNIMPLEMENTED GENERIC SAFETY ISSUES AT SHEARON HARRIS NUCLEAR
POWER PLANT, UNIT NO. 1 (TAC NO. 75993)

On April 25, 1990, the staff issued Generic Letter 90-04 which requested information concerning the implementation status of certain generic safety issues (GSIs) at your facility. Based on your response to this Generic Letter, dated June 28, 1990, our own records and discussions with your staff, we have updated our database on GSI implementation status. The results of this effort were presented to the Commission at a meeting on October 25, 1990.

The enclosure to this letter summarizes the staff's understanding of the current status of those GSIs which remain unimplemented at Shearon Harris Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 1. We appreciate the assistance you provided in responding to Generic Letter 90-04 and we encourage your timely completion of those GSIs listed in the enclosure.
