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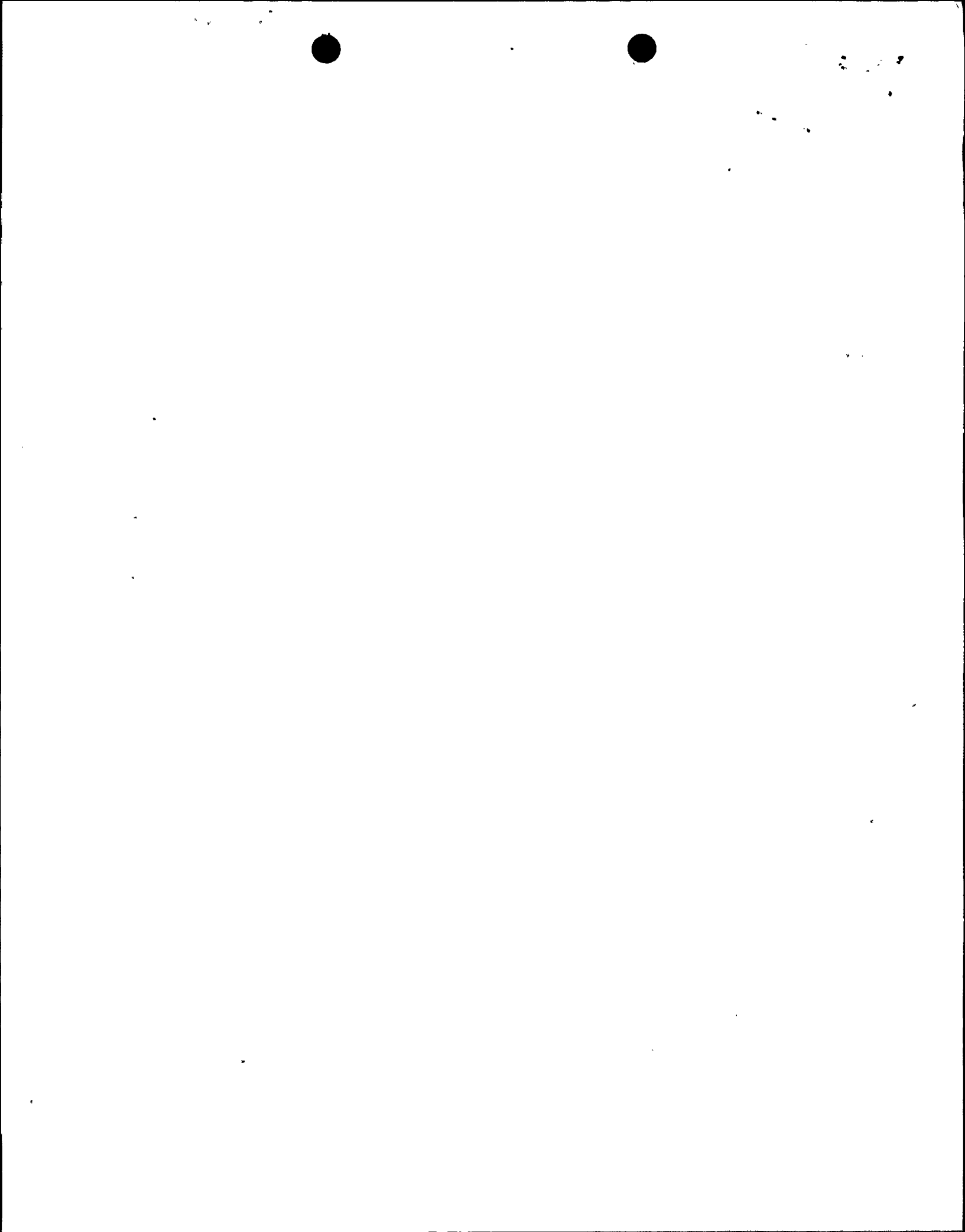
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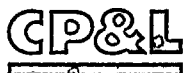

Gentlemen:

By letters dated May 15, 1993 and February 17, 1994, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) submitted a proposed license amendment that would remove license conditions for the Emergency Diesel Generators (EDGs) specified by Condition 2.C.(8) and defined in Attachment 1 to Operating License NPF-63. Since a generic evaluation by the NRC will not be completed in time to support CP&L's upcoming refueling outage, CP&L hereby supplements the May 15, 1993 and February 17, 1994 requests for a license amendment to provide for a one-time exemption from compliance with License Condition 2.C.(8). However, this supplement does not alter CP&L's request for removal of the license conditions upon completion of the generic evaluation.

Carolina Power & Light Company's May 15, 1993 request was pre-noticed by the NRC in the Federal Register dated June 9, 1993. This one-time exemption request does not alter the conclusions contained in either CP&L's 10 CFR 50.92 evaluation or that Federal Register Notice. Furthermore, this one-time exemption from the EDG license conditions is based upon the same justification as that presented for removal of the license conditions. The safety evaluation to remove the license conditions applies to this one-time exemption request. Based upon both CP&L-specific and industry operating experience with these engines, it is probable that the overall margin of safety for the Shearon Harris Nuclear Power Plant will be increased based on a higher availability and engine reliability. Therefore, this change will not result in a decrease in EDG availability or reliability.

Proposed wording to License Condition 2.C.(8) to incorporate this one-time exemption is contained in Attachment 1.

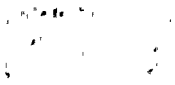

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

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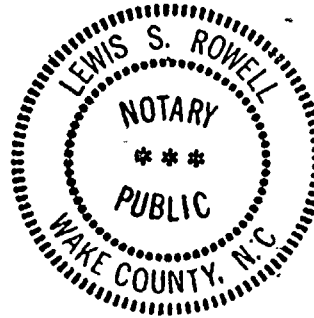

Carolina Power & Light Company shall implement the TDI diesel requirements as specified in Attachment 1. Attachment 1 is hereby incorporated into this license. However, Carolina Power & Light Company is granted a one-time exemption from implementing these requirements during Refueling Outage No. 5 and the ensuing Operating Cycle No. 6.
