Dear Mr. Gallagher:

I write on behalf of Hospital Management Associates, LLC (“Seller”), which holds 95.84% of the membership interests of Williamson Memorial Hospital, LLC (the “Company”). The Company owns and operates Williamson Memorial Hospital, an acute care hospital located in Williamson, West Virginia (the “Hospital”). Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 30.34(b), the purpose of this letter is to provide notice to the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the “NRC”) of the anticipated change of ownership of the Hospital and to obtain the consent of the NRC to the transfer of control of the above-referenced radioactive materials license issued by the NRC.

We have sent several notice letters to the NRC regarding the proposed change of ownership. For reference, on September 1, 2017, we provided notice regarding the anticipated change of ownership of the Hospital through a transaction in which Collaborative Healthcare Solutions, LLC would acquire substantially all of the assets and operations of the Company, including the Hospital. On September 27, 2017, we provided notice that the anticipated change of ownership would be effective November 1, 2017 and in addition, that Mountaineer Community Hospital, LLC would acquire substantially all of the assets and operations of the Company, including the Hospital—not Collaborative Healthcare Solutions, LLC. Most recently, on November 27, 2017, we provided notice to that the anticipated effective date of the transaction would be December 31, 2017.0

Please be advised that the parties are negotiating a definitive agreement that, subject to the satisfaction or waiver of certain conditions, will result in Collaborative Healthcare Solutions, LLC and Kingsman Capital, LLC (collectively, the “Buyers”) acquiring all of the membership interests of the Company currently held by the Seller (the “Proposed Transaction”). The parties anticipate that the Proposed Transaction will occur effective January 1, 2018.

Other than changes resulting in the ordinary course of business, no change in the local administrative management or day-to-day operations of the Hospital is anticipated as a result of the Proposed Transaction. In particular, the Proposed Transaction will not result in any change in the use, possession, location, or storage of licensed radioactive materials at the Hospital, nor will it result in any change in the Hospital’s equipment, procedures, or personnel operating under the Company’s current radioactive materials license.
