#### Revisions to the HNP Emergency Plan - Rev. 26

- EAL revisions to address NRC EPOS # 1 deletion of several classifications
  - Unplanned ECCS discharge
  - Contaminated or Potentially Contaminated injured individual being transported offsite for medical treatment
  - Loss of all representative meteorological data
- EAL revisions to clarify U/E classifications for:
  - Existing Initiating Conditions: "Aircraft crash within EAB or unusual aircraft activity over the facility", "Train Derailment within EAB", "Unplanned explosion within EAB" &" Unplanned toxic or flammable gas release within EAB"
  - Revised following NUMARC / NESP 007 guidelines -"Aircraft, train or other vehicle crash that may potentially damage plant structures containing functions or systems required for safe shutdown of the plant", "Unplanned explosion within the protected area resulting in visible damage to permanent structures or equipment" & "Unplanned toxic or flammable gas release within the EAB"
