Dear Sir or Madam:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of a modification to a commitment for the Harris Nuclear Plant. We have discussed in numerous letters and meetings our commitment to perform a comprehensive review of the implementation of our Technical Specification surveillance requirements (reference LER 95-007, LER 96-002-13, LER 97-012, and 2/11/97 response to 10CFR50.54(f) request concerning design basis information). This review has also been mentioned in several other letters, although not specifically as a corrective action (LER 97-021-02, LER 97-023, LER 97-024, and LER 98-005). We are currently performing this review in conjunction with our conversion to the Improved Standard Technical Specifications.

In an effort to focus our resources in the most important areas, we have decided to modify the scope of the commitment. The original plan was to review all surveillance requirements. However, we are now planning to review as part of this project only the surveillance requirements which will be retained in Technical Specifications (TS) when we convert to the Improved Technical Specifications (ITS). The determination of which surveillance requirements need to be reviewed at this time will be based on the draft Application of TS Selection Criteria Report which has been completed as part of our TS conversion effort. The surveillance requirements which have been judged to not meet the NRC criteria delineated in 10CFR50.36 are planned to be relocated out of the TS. These relocated surveillance requirements are considered to be a lower priority, and will receive an appropriate review as part of the implementation of ITS instead of being reviewed at this time.

In summary, the commitment to perform this review should be modified to state: "A comprehensive review of the implementation of Technical Specification surveillance requirements for those surveillances that are planned to be retained as part of the ITS will be completed." Current plans are to complete this review in 1999.


