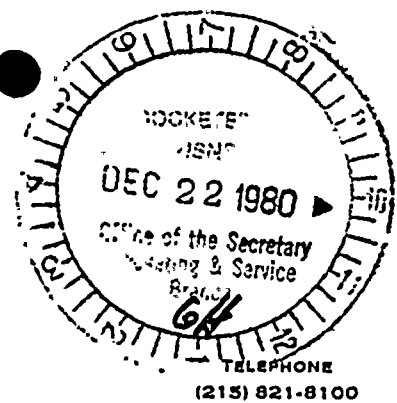

Dear Mr. Bechhoefer:

On October 23, 1980, I made a request under 10 CFR § 2.715 to make a limited appearance statement at the licensing proceedings for the above captioned facilities.

I was notified by the Docketing and Service Section that my request was referred to the Board.

In order for me to make a meaningful statement, it is necessary that I know which contentions of the various parties are being accepted by the Board for consideration. A number of specific contentions are of particular interest to me, including among others the possible inadequacy of the applicant's health effects and population dose models, and the adequacy of the applicant's evacuation plans.

I understand that the policy of the Board is to provide those granted the right to make limited appearance statements with only the notices of hearing, and the initial decision of the Board. This no doubt serves the needs of most of those making appearances under § 2.715.

However, inasmuch as I would like to address the specific issues raised by the parties, I would like to receive copies of all prior and future decisions and orders, pre-hearing and otherwise, entered by the Board at the above captioned docket numbers.

Kindly advise whether the Board may accommodate this request. If additional information is required, please contact me.
