Mr. Purdum,

This refers to your application to renew your license dated December 4, 2017. In order to continue our review of your request, the following additional information is needed:

1. The address for your facility and location of use listed on your current license is different from the address for your facility and location of use described on your application for renewal. Please explain the difference in addresses.
2. On your current license, it allows you to possess up to 10 Troxler Model 3216, 3217, 3218 and 3400 Series portable gauges. In your license renewal application, it states that you would like to be licensed for 1 Troxler Model 3400 Series portable gauge. Please verify how many and what types of portable gauges you would like to possess under your license.

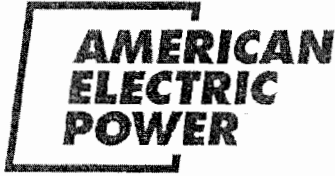

Mr. Wardrobe,

The following are responses to the request for additional information emailed to Chris Purdum from Leo Wardrobe on December 18, 2017:

1. The address of our facility, which is the location of use, has changed from U. S. Route 33 to State Route 62. The reason is the West Virginia Department of Highways changed the number when a new Route 33 was constructed to extend the existing route in southeast Ohio, to connect with the existing route in West Virginia, north of our facility. The designation for the existing Route 62 was extended to the north and renamed where Route 33 used to be.

No physical changes were made to our facility or location of use, only the number designation for the state highway changed in our address.


2. The current license allows up to 10 sources each of Cs-137 and Am-241. The only gauge possessed under this license is 1 Troxler Model 3400 Series gauge. To maintain flexibility for the potential purchase of future gauges, this amount is requested to change to 2 Troxler Model 3400 Series portable gauges. This would be a total amount allowed in possession at one time of 20 mCi of Cs-137 and 100 mCi of Am-241, not to exceed 10 mCi and 50 mCi of Cs-137 and Am-241, respectively, for each source.

If possible, I would like to take this opportunity to update the AEP RSO contact information on file with the NRC. I noticed in the email sent to me on 12-7-2017 from James R. Cassata regarding our license expiration that Joseph Beer was listed with his contact information. The AEP Corporate RSO is now Francis A. Ginocchi. Frank is the Director, Safety & Health – Generation. He is located at the AEP Headquarters Building in Columbus, Ohio. His phone number is 614-716-1710 and his email is fmginocchi@aep.com.
