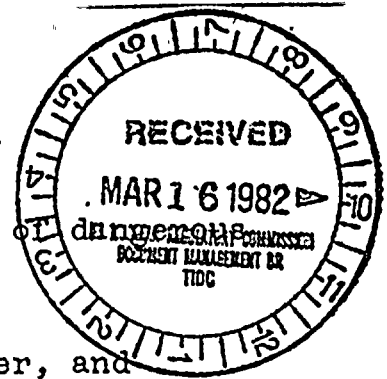

RESOLUTION FOR NUCLEAR PLANT SAFETY



Whereas nuclear power plants contain large amounts of radioactive material, and

Whereas the public needs protection from this danger, and

Whereas Carolina Power & Light is building the Harris nuclear plant within 30 miles of all of Durham,

The *Morehead School Democratic* precinct committee resolves that

there should be comprehensive, independent radiation monitoring of the Harris nuclear plant site and the area within 30 miles of it, including plant life and wildlife, before the nuclear plant starts up,

And that comprehensive, continuous, independent radiation monitoring go on as long as the nuclear plant is licensed to operate,

And that CP&L, the owner of the nuclear plant, should pay for equipment and salaries for people to operate it, to do this radiation checking for every town and county and city within 30 miles of the Harris nuclear plant site.

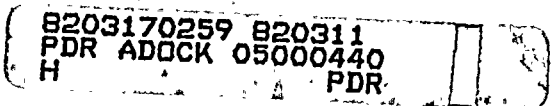
