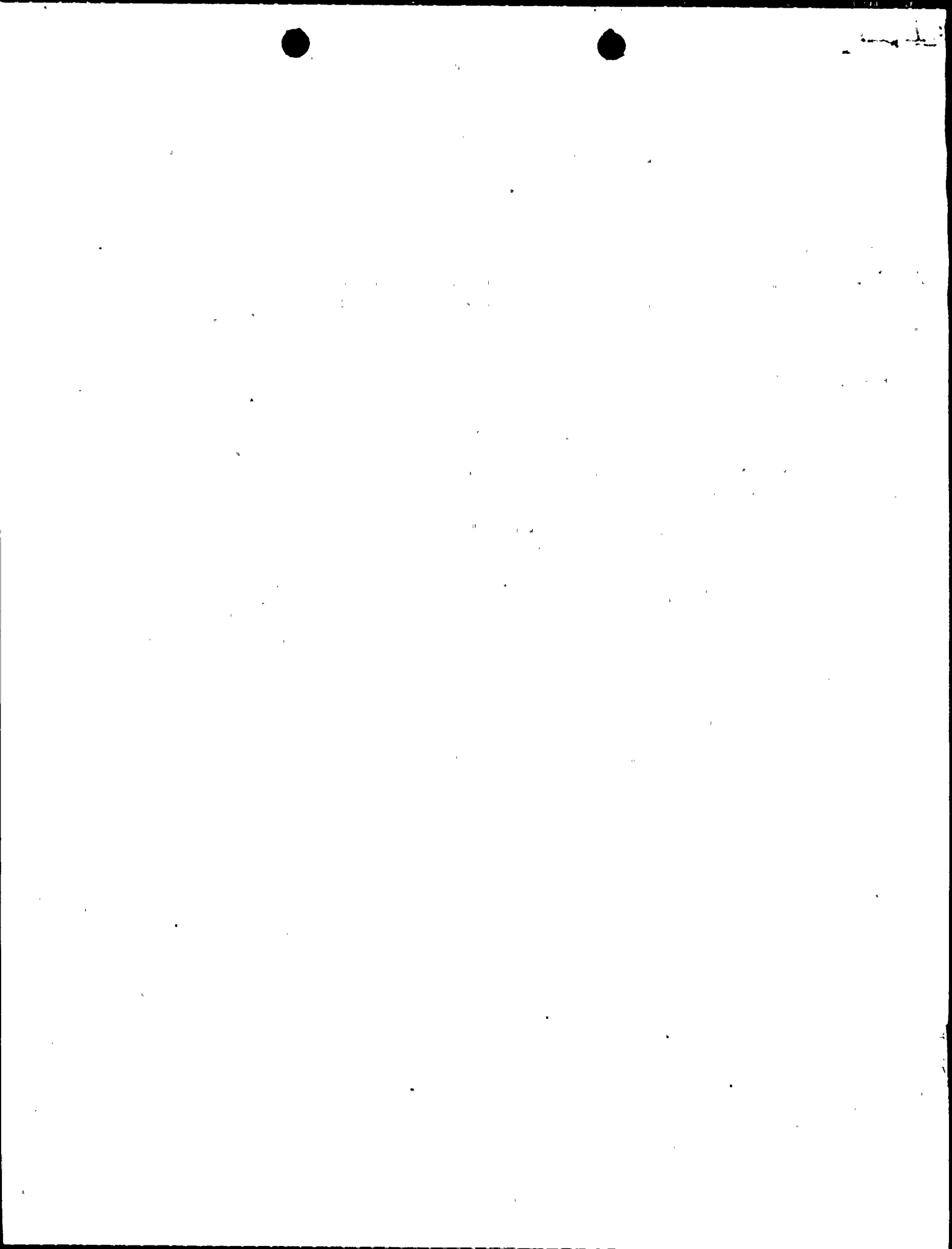

On April 13, 1978, I met with three NRC Staff attorneys--namely, Messrs. Englehardt, Bordenick and Lieberman to discuss various matters pertaining to the co-ownership of the Nine Mile Point 2 facility by other New York utilities.

During the course of that conference, I was asked if any monies had been advanced by the co-owners to Niagara Mohawk. To this question, I replied "yes." I was further asked if there had been any transfer by deed or otherwise of any portion of the facility or site from Niagara Mohawk to the other co-owners. To this I replied in the negative. This latter fact remains true. There has been no transfer of any interest in the facility or the site to the co-owners by Niagara Mohawk.
