Don,

Thanks for the documentation. I have attached a clear inspection report for your records, as we discussed. I have also attached NRC form 314 for license termination, if you should choose to close the license out.

There is a requirement, in 10 CFR 30.36(d)(3), that if no principle activities have been conducted within two years, that you notify the NRC and let us know of your intent to close out the license or ask for an extension. Because you have been applying for decommissioning work at SONGS, which is essential to achieving the purpose for which the license was issued, it appears you have conducted principle activities in the past two years.
