Dear Dr. Reimer:

I received your letter dated January 15, 2018 (Agencywide Documents Access Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML18017A784) regarding the Licensee's December 15, 2017, response (ADAMS Accession No. ML18009A456) to a request for information from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) about sediment sample collection at the Pohakuloa Training Area (PTA). In your letter, you comment on the Licensee's response and ask about obtaining information about three samples that the Licensee has already collected.

The December 15, 2017 response is related to your Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 2.206 petition. Therefore, I provided a copy of your January 15, 2018 letter to the Petition Review Board (PRB) for the PRB's consideration.

With regard to obtaining environmental data that was recently collected by the Licensee at the PTA, the Licensee is not required to submit nor has the Licensee submitted this information to the NRC. I will forward your request, with your personal identifiable information redacted, to the Licensee. The information you request may be inspected by the NRC staff during routine inspections. Inspection reports document what was inspected and they are typically issued 30 to 45 calendar days after the inspections and are made publicly available. For more information on the materials inspection program, please refer to the "Inspection Manual Chapter 2800, Materials Inspection Program" (ADAMS Accession No. ML17186A204).
