Notice is hereby given that by Petition dated August 23, 1976, The Environmental Coalition on Nuclear Power filed a request for an Order to Show Cause why Construction Permits Nos. CPPR-101 and CPPR-102 should not be suspended. The requested order would be issued to Pennsylvania Power and Light Company for the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, Units Nos. 1 and 2.
