
Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by D. S. Price of this office on May 29-31, 1979 of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. DPR-33, DPR-52 and DPR-68 for the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant facility, Units 1, 2 and 3, and to the discussion of our findings held with J. G. Dewease at the conclusion of the inspection.
