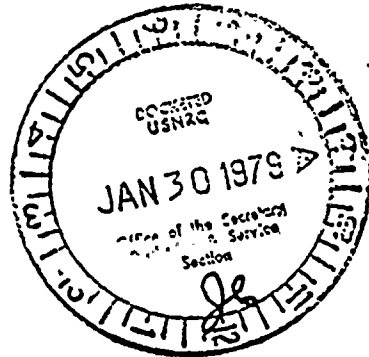

Thank you for your attention to this request.

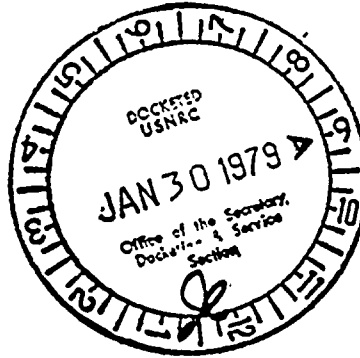

Dear Mr. Childs:

I am writing to ask permission to make a limited appearance statement on January 30 at the licensing hearing for Pennsylvania Power and Light's nuclear plant, the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station. For over three years PP&L's information center and representatives have been assuring the public of the safety of nuclear power plants in general, and of the SSES in particular, often citing the executive summary of the Reactor Safety Study. Since you at the NRC have withdrawn your support of the summary, labeling it potentially "misleading" and "deceptive", I believe that PP&L has the responsibility to notify all the groups to whom its representatives have spoken and all the people who have visited its information center, that the claims for safety made in the name of the Rasmussen Report are unsupported and may be incorrect. It may be the case that public acceptance of this project has been based on these baseless assurances.

Will you also please include my name on the service list for your mailings about the hearings on the SSES.
