WITH THE ORDER OF AUGUST 24, 1979.

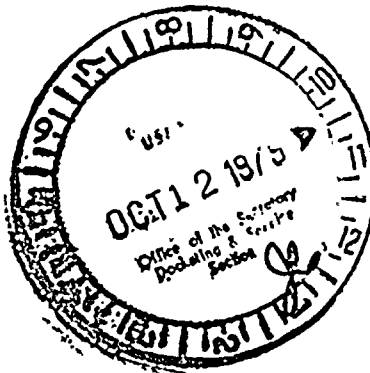
THE FACT THAT, BECAUSE OF THE FAILURE OF THE NRC STAFF TO ISSUE THE
