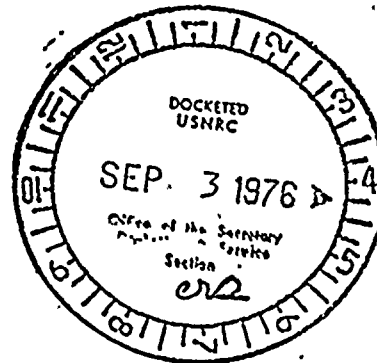

On August 26, 1976, we obtained from the Public Document Room an unsigned, unsworn and undated document entitled "Petition to Intervene" which states that it is being filed by the Environmental Coalition on Nuclear Power. This document petitions the Commission "for leave to intervene in this proceeding." The Petition includes a number of contentions relating to the cost-benefit analyses determined for Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2. No copies of the "Petition" were served on Pennsylvania Power & Light Company or its undersigned counsel.


The cover letter which transmitted this and other petitions to the Secretary of the Commission referred to affidavits and authorizations, in addition to the petitions.
