Dear Sirs,

I understand that the Susquehanna Plant has been completed and ready to generate power, but that licensing delays will keep the plant out of operation for possibly a year or more; all at great cost to the operating company and ultimately its stockholders. Also that such delay will mean burning up to 15 million more barrels of imported oil.

As a small stock and bond holder in this company I deplore failure to allow this and other such plants to commence operations at the earliest possible time after completion. I consider it a national disgrace to allow a loud and militant minority to stifle this country's nuclear generation, as it has been able to do these past few years.

I respectfully urge that every consideration be given to a prompt licensing of this and other plants.
