I am writing to report that a Cs-137 source that was part of an instrument in the Biology Department of the University was transferred to the Physics Department. 
1. The source transferred was a 16.6 μC Cs-137 source. The source was inside the Beckman LS100C liquid scintillation counter that was used in the Biology department of Valparaiso University. The equipment was obsolete and needed to be disposed of. Hence the Cs-137 source was removed and transferred to the Nuclear physics laboratory of Valparaiso University to be used by students for physics experiments.
2. The source was received by Dr. Shirvel Stanislaus, Professor of Physics and the RSO of the Physics Department of Valparaiso University.
