RESTART CRITERIA

1. SPECIFIC DEFICIENCY WITH SIGNIFICANT PROBABILITY OF SYSTEM INOPERABILITY
- AS MEASURED BY TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION REQUIREMENTS
2. PROGRAMMATIC DEFICIENCY WITH HIGH PROBABILITY OF SYSTEM INOPERABILITY
- AS MEASURED BY TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION REQUIREMENTS
3. SPECIFIC DEFICIENCY RESULTING IN NONCOMPLIANCE WITH NRC REGULATIONS
4. TVA HAS MADE A SPECIFIC COMMITMENT TO NRC
5. SPECIFIC DEFICIENCY WITH SIGNIFICANT PROBABILITY OF PERSONAL INJURY
6. DEFICIENCY MAY CAUSE FORCED OUTAGE



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TVA RESTART CRITERIA IMPLEMENTATION

1. TVA WILL DETERMINE THE ITEMS REQUIRED FOR RESTART BASED UPON A CONSISTENT APPLICATION OF THE RESTART CRITERIA
2. THE RESTART CRITERIA ARE APPLIED TO A DEFINED SET OF TRACKED OPEN ITEMS
3. RESTART DETERMINATIONS RECEIVED A MANAGER LEVEL REVIEW
4. NEW OPEN ITEMS ARE SUBJECT TO THE RESTART DETERMINATION PROCESS
5. THE RESTART DETERMINATION AND CLOSURE PROCESS IS CONTROLLED BY PROCEDURE
6. THE RESULTS OF THE RESTART DETERMINATION ARE RECORDED, MAINTAINED, AND PERIODICALLY REPORTED
7. ITEMS FOR RESTART PUBLISHED IN NUCLEAR PERFORMANCE PLAN WILL NOT BE CHANGED FROM RESTART TO POST-RESTART WITHOUT APPROVAL OF MANAGER OF NUCLEAR POWER
