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10. As a condition of this license not more than four fuel elements at any one time may be out of approved storage racks or shipping containers.

- 11. The licensee is hereby exempted from the requirements of Section 70.24, 10 CFR 70, insofar as this section applies to the material held under this license.
- 12. As a condition of this license fuel elements shall be stored in such a manner that water would drain freely from the elements in the event of flooding and subsequent draining of a storage area.
