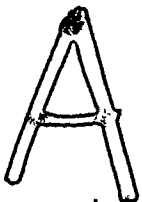


BROWNS FERRY NUCLEAR PLANT (BFN) - SEMIANNUAL RADIOACTIVE EFFLUENT RELEASE
