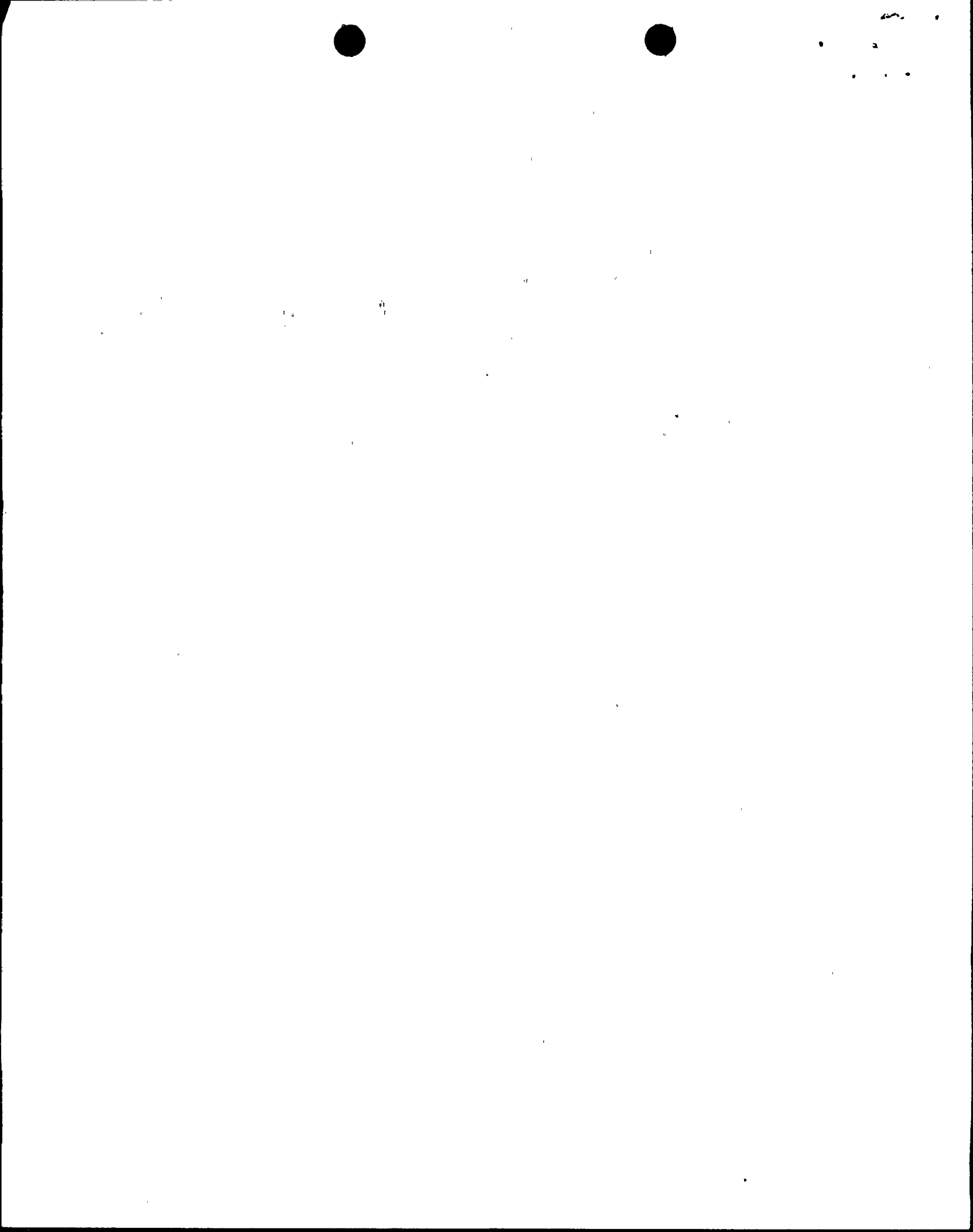



BROWNS FERRY NUCLEAR PLANT (BFN) - LANDFILL PERMIT NO. 42-02 -;
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

This is in response to your August 30, 1988 letter regarding additional regulations for facilities having landfill disposal permits. A copy of BFN procedure PMI 25.4 (Plant Manager's Instruction) is enclosed which governs the operation and daily inspection of BFN's onsite landfill, and the types of materials that may be disposed in it. Wastes generated at BFN, not specified by the permit, are handled in strict accordance with the enclosed procedure and are managed as either hazardous waste or special waste as appropriate. Additionally, BFN does not accept wastes from anyone outside site boundaries.
