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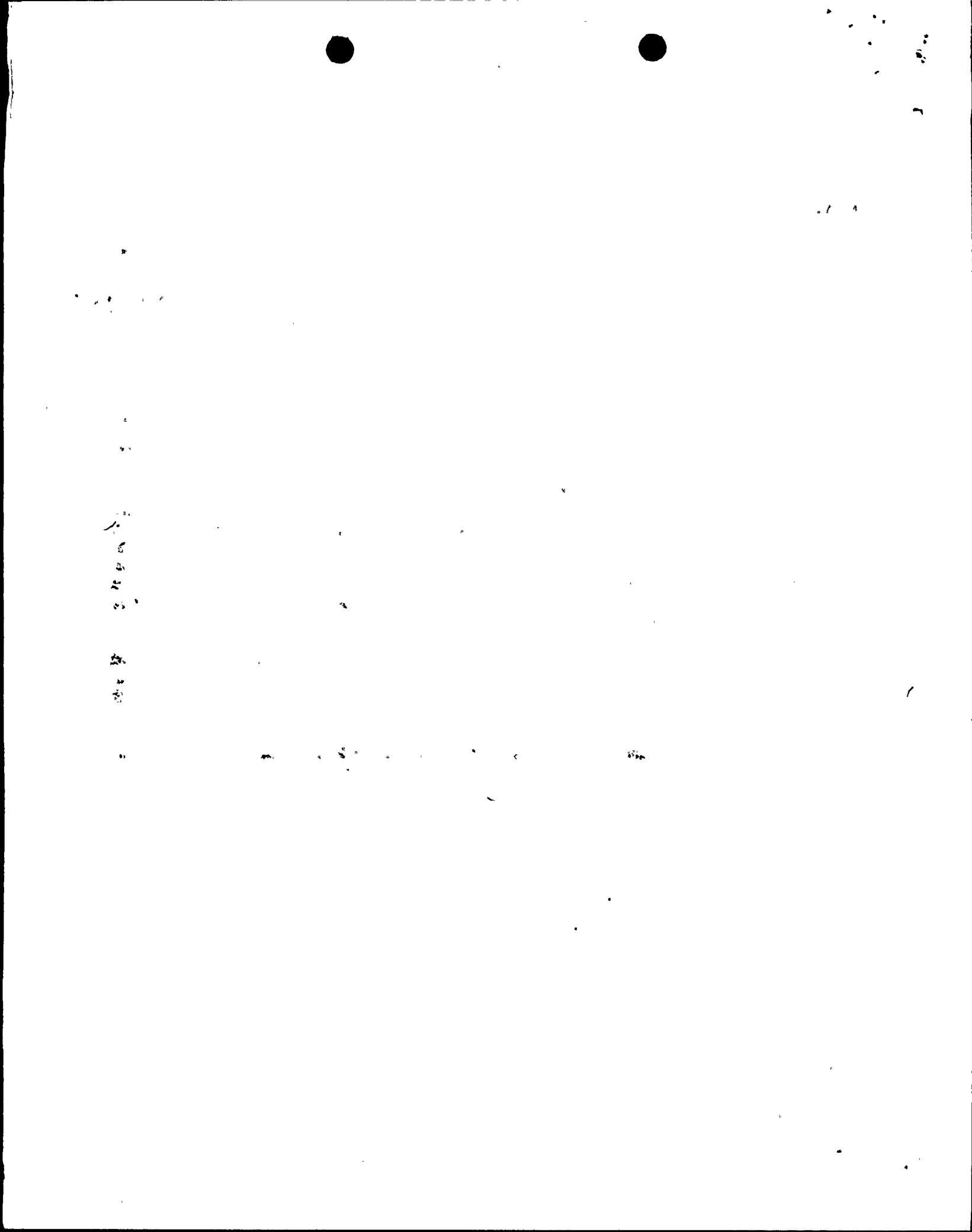

In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.4 and 50.90, TVA is submitting a request for an amendment to license DPR-52 to change the BFN TSs for Unit 2 (Enclosure 1). The proposed amendment will incorporate new allowable values for the HPCI and RCIC steam line space instruments channels in Table 3.2.B, revise Table 3.2.B to delete note 4 and add note 1.E, revise Tables 3.2.B and 4.2.B to distinguish between specific areas where steam line temperature is being monitored, and revise bases section 3.2 to be consistent with the other changes.

A summary of the proposed changes is provided in Enclosure 2. The reason and justification for the proposed changes is provided in Enclosure 3. A proposed determination of no significant hazards consideration is provided in Enclosure 4.
