- The results of the performance analysis that was performed for the written examination

Forms ES-201-3, Examination Security Agreement, with Pre- and Post-examination signatures will be delivered as soon as all the Post-examination signatures have been collected and within 20 calendar days of exam administration.

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Per our discussion with Michael Bielby, we request the NRC withhold public disclosure of the exam in ADAMS for 2 years so we can have the exam available for internal use.

Additionally, we request RO Admin JPM RA-4, ACTIVATE EVERBRIDGENOTIFICATION, along with the associated procedure EPA 17-001 ERO NOTIFICATION OR AUGMENTATION – TRAINING USE be withheld from public disclosure because it contains proprietary information.
