On January 5, 2018 (Reference), American Centrifuge Operating, LLC (ACO) submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) an updated Decommissioning Plan (DP) for the American Centrifuge Lead Cascade Facility (Lead Cascade) as required by the commitment made within Chapter 10.0 of the License Application. During subsequent discussions with NRC, ACO determined that the DP should be incorporated into the Lead Cascade materials license upon NRC approval.
