
Jay County Memorial Hospital will be transferring control of its Materials License, Number 13-20329-01 to Indiana University Health Jay, Inc. as of March 1, 2018. In accordance with NUREG 1556, Volume 15, Revision 1, please accept the following description of the transfer of control:

1. The transaction will be a full asset purchase and will be final as of March 1, 2018. The new facility name will be Indiana University Health Jay, Inc., with a mailing address of 500 West Votaw Street, Portland, IN 47371, and a contact phone number of 260-726-7131.
2. There will be no changes in personnel or duties in regards to the transfer of control at this time. The Radiation Safety Officer and Authorized Users will remain the same.
3. There will be no changes in the organization, location, facilities, equipment, or procedures that relate to the licensed program.
4. The surveillance program that is currently in place complies with USNRC regulations. Daily radiation surveys, weekly radioactive contamination surveys, quarterly sealed source inventory and leak tests, and personal dosimetry are currently performed. The transfer of control will not alter the current surveillance program.
5. The transfer of control will not change the current decommissioning funding plans in place.
6. We confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be maintained at the current address of use listed on License Number 13-20329-01. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity. If the License is terminated in the future, the records

will be transferred to Indiana University Health Jay, Inc. or the USNRC, as appropriate.


7. By signing below, we confirm that both the transferor and the transferee agree to the transfer of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of transfer and that the transferee has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.
8. We confirm that the transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, and commitments of the transferor.

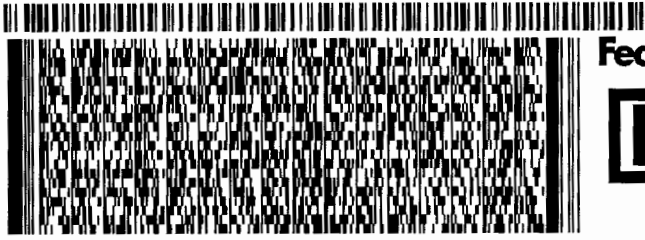

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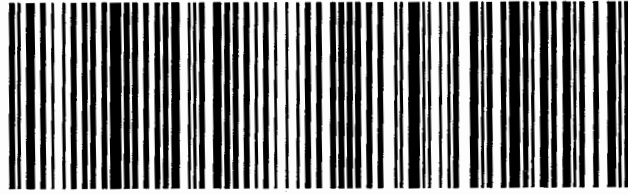
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2. Place the label in a waybill pouch and affix it to your shipment so that the barcode portion of the label can be read and scanned.
