
I am writing to confirm the status of Dr. Salvador Borges-Neto as an Authorized User of radioactive material for clinical purposes at Duke University Medical Center. Our medical license does not list individual Authorized Users.

Condition 12 of Duke University's Medical License of Broad Scope with the State of North Carolina (NC 032-0247-4; expires January 31, 2027) stipulates that Authorized Users be approved by vote of the Duke University Medical Center Radiation Control and Radioactive Drug Research Committee. Approval is contingent upon fulfillment of the requirements set forth in the Duke University Radiation Safety Manual and the statutes of the State of North Carolina (10A NCAC 15). These requirements include certification by the American Board of Nuclear Medicine or the American Board of Radiology, possession of a full, unrestricted active-status license for the practice of medicine in North Carolina, and completion of an accredited post-graduate residency program. Dr. Borges-Neto was approved by the Committee as Authorized Users on 27 October 1994.

Dr. Borges-Neto is authorized for the therapeutic and diagnostic use of radionuclides from atomic numbers 3 – 83 inclusive, in any form or amount on an "as needed for medical use" basis. This would include all uses under 10 CFR 35.100, .200 and .300.
