Dear Mr. Bouchard,

This is in reference to your letter dated January 22, 2018, requesting to terminate Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 06-09667-03, Docket No. 03019056. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Based upon our records review, it would appear that some rooms may have not been surveyed that would be required to be surveyed. In a document dated July 29, 2002, it was stated that GR-43 was currently in use and the following rooms would be used, N104 (sealed sources), N205, N206, N207, N202 (Waste Room), N203 (Instrument Lab), N307 (Dark Room), and 225A. These rooms were to be used after moving from Labs 222, 233, 239, 245, and 242 which were released. Additionally, Dr. Brian Walker's lab was requested in June 18, 2010, which is unclear what the room number was for that lab. Please clarify or provide additional surveys.
2. During the history of this license, it was licensed for various sealed sources including atomic number 1 through 83, Am-241, and Cm-244. Please provide the last leak test for any sources requiring leak testing and state the room numbers where these sources were stored. In particular, the Cm-244 source which decays mainly by alpha.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office (Address below) and refer to Mail Control No. 602362. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.
