In January we stated contacting Chase Environmental Group, Inc. (Chase) for them to remove and dispose of the Texas Nuclear gauges listed below:


- Texas Nuclear fixed gauge Model 5191 containing cesium-137 sealed source located in Building 53
- Texas Nuclear fixed gauge Model 5201 containing cesium-137 sealed source located in Building 87

This letter is to provide the communication of proceeding with the use of Chase for the source removal and disposal.

Cargill has contacted the Chase from Louisville, Kentucky operating under Tennessee license R-53008-E19 with expiration May 31, 2019 to proceed with the remove and dispose of the Texas Nuclear gauges Model numbers 5191 and 5201. Chase will provide a Radiation Safety specialist to remove and properly package the sources for transport to the disposal facility. Chase will also arrange for transportation to Waste Control Specialists (WCS) in Andrews, Texas operating under Texas license R04100 with expiration September 10, 2024.

Cargill will provide the NRC with post notification amendment and maintain the associated records as required by our license.
