Dear Mr. Stripe,

This is in reference to your letter dated February 20, 2018, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 37-35160-01, Docket No. 03038757. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. You have requested to add a new location of use onto your license. [NUREG-1556, Volume 1, Revision 2](#), "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Portable Gauge Licenses, Final Report" states in section 8.9 to "Provide a facility diagram for each permanent portable gauge storage location. Include on the diagram the use of adjacent areas (including above and below), and information relevant to public dose and security as discussed in Sections 8.10.5, "Public Dose," and 8.10.6, "Operating, Emergency, and Security Procedures," respectively, in NUREG-1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 2, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Portable Gauge Licenses." Please provide a diagram of your new facility, where the gauges will be stored, adjacent areas to the storage, areas above and below, along with information relevant to public dose and how you will provide security as it is related to requirements in 10 CFR 30.34(i).
2. You state in your letter that a move is scheduled to occur but did not give a proposed date. Please provide when you plan to move to the new facility.
3. Your request implies that this is a move from one location to another. Normally this is done by adding a facility in one amendment and removing a facility in another amendment. Sometimes, portable gauge licensee's perform this in one amendment by transferring their gauges to an authorized recipient like the manufacturer or other qualified vendor for maintenance, use at a temporary job site, transfer to a location under an Agreement State license that the licensee possess, or some combination of the above. If you would like to remove the location of use at 27 Travato Street, Suite 1, Bridgeport, West Virginia with this amendment, please state the status of where you are possessing the gauges and provide the latest leak test of all gauges that have ever been stored at the 27 Travato Street, Suite 1 location. Alternately, state that leak tests were current and no leak tests have showed leaking sources. If you do not wish to remove this location at this time, then provide the leak test information with your next amendment request.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office (Address below) and refer to Mail Control No. 602462. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter. The letter may be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email; or it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269; or it may be sent by regular mail. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to

pursue your application OR amendment request.
