Enclosed is Amendment No. 14 to your U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Material License No. 21-26168-01 for Molina Medical Group of Michigan in accordance with your request dated November 21, 2017. Your letter is available electronically from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML18005A832. Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we may provide appropriate corrections and answers.

In your request dated November 21, 2017, you provided the history of use and close-out survey and wipe test results for Molina Medical Group of Michigan located at 4700 Schaefer Road, Dearborn, Michigan. You also confirmed that all residual licensed material used at this location had been removed – such that any remaining residual radioactivity is within the limits of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) Part 20, Subpart E.

Based on its review of close-out survey information, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the location of use and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities in this location of use does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility at 4700 Schaefer Road, Dearborn, Michigan is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license No. 21-26168-01 is hereby terminated.
