The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received a license application from Holtec International (Holtec) to construct and operate a consolidated interim storage facility for spent nuclear fuel at the Holtec site in Lea County, New Mexico. We are reaching out to the Carlsbad Public Library to request its assistance in establishing an information repository and maintaining reference documents at the library. The documents are associated with the NRC's environmental review of the Holtec HI-STORE license application.
